Drafting of Recommendations

The EAB did not have a quorum. Members present drafted the following recommendations for the Goddard School at Winmore.

- 1) A clerestory is recommended for natural lighting, building climate control, and in consideration of Carrboro vernacular
- 2) Recommend the following revisions to the planting plan
 - a. Recommend Red Maple as an alternative to Sugar Maple
 - b. Because of the potential for deer overgrazing, recommend Virginia Sweetspire as an alternative to Sweet Pepper Bush and Glossy Abelia as an alternative to Oakleaf hydrangea and Indian Hawthorn
 - c. Shrub list is lacking in native plants. Specifically, recommend dwarf Yaupon Holly as an alternative to Japanese Holly
