The first time I came to a meeting of the Carrboro Board was when Winmore was approved. Like my neighbors I came to oppose Winmore. But my reason for opposing that development was different than theirs. From my readings on smart growth and discussion I had with national smart growth experts, I was convinced that Winmore was not really smart growth. My reasons for opposing Winmore at the time were primarily two fold. First, it seemed too small to become a hub for transportation and commerce. Second, it was designed as a one-way-in-one-way-out development. After and during the Boards discussions of Winmore, I had three relevant discussions. One conversation was with Bob Chapman, who showed me plans for at least two expansions of Winmore. He seemed very capable and said he hoped I would support requests for latter phases of Winmore. I believe he even showed me plans for them. Another conversation was with a local smart growth expert, whose name I never knew. He said that he had consulted on smart growth projects that were as small as or smaller than Winmore and that they had a positive effect on the number of automobile trips taken. The third conversation was with two members of the Board. At the time I didn't know anyone on the board except Jackie. I am not sure I can identify the two board members I talked too. They both were male and I think one was Mike Nelson. If I understood them correctly, I was told that the size of Winmore was dictated by the County and that Carrboro hoped to have more (contiguous) smart growth. Since that time I have seen little indication that northeast Carrboro will have continued smart growth, although, I have been pleased that at least the roads in Clarmont will connect to the roads in Winmore. When the Board approved Clarmont, I came to the meeting to oppose it, but I did not speak because I was convinced that the Board had no tools to oppose the development. The developers had played by the rules as they stood. I saw the Clarmont development as inconsistent with what I see as Carrboro's attempt at smart growth. I still hope the smart growth experiment in northeast Carrboro can be a success but it seems to me the board needs tools to be able pursue it. I hope this review committee can help to provide those tools.

There is one other point I would like to make. I live in the recently annexed northeast Carrboro. I would like to be on this committee but not as a representative of this area. I am not, at least in terms of the issues to be considered by this committee, representative of my neighbors.
