**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this agenda item is to add several streets to the list of streets and street sections (and/or associated rights-of-way and sidewalks) on which people may not sell or attempt to sell any goods.

**INFORMATION**

One of the goals of the original ordinance adopted on March 27, 1984 was to prevent the selling of goods in locations where such activity would be undesirable or unsafe in some respect. The addition of these streets to the list of those where such activity is prohibited is designed to maintain and maximize available parking for the Carrboro Farmers' Market and also to reinforce the ability of the Carrboro Farmers' Market to continue exercising some control over who is selling goods on Carrboro Farmers' Market days in the near vicinity of the market.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Town staff recommends that the Board consider adopting this ordinance.
