**PURPOSE**

The purpose of this item is to receive public input on a Street Closing Permit Application submitted by the UNC Kidney Center for the temporary closing and usage of streets to accommodate the Kidney Kare 5K Run/Walk on Saturday March 21, 2009 from 8:25 AM to 9:45 AM.

**INFORMATION**

This is the fourth year the UNC Kidney Center will be holding this event. The UNC Kidney Center has submitted a Street Closing Permit Application for the temporary closing and usage of the following streets on March 21, 2009 from 8:25 AM to 9:45 AM:

1. Start and Finish on McDougale Southeast Drive
2. Right on *Hillsborough Rd* (Stay on Hillsborough Rd through the N Greensboro St split)
3. Right on *High St*
4. Right on *Main St* (stay in bike lane)
5. Right on *James St*
6. Left on *Hillsborough Rd* (stay in bike lane)
7. Left on *McDougale Southeast Drive*

In accordance with Section 7-19 of the Town Code, a Public Hearing to receive public input prior to issuing a Street Closing Permit is required for this particular event.

**RECOMMENDATION**

Staff recommends that the Board approve the attached resolution for the temporary closing and usage of the following streets in order to accommodate the Kidney Kare 5K Run/Walk under the following stipulations:

1. Applicant shall distribute flyers of notification, to persons occupying property abutting the streets where the event is to take place, of the contents of any resolution passed.
2. Applicant will be responsible for all costs incurred by Police and Public Works to facilitate this event. Applicant will be sent an itemized bill for the final costs incurred by Police and Public Works.
