PURPOSE

The Durham-Chapel Hill-Carrboro Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) has asked member jurisdictions to develop general timelines for implementation of local transportation projects. This is because a rescission of federal transportation funding that occurred in September 2009 may affect when local projects can be funded.

INFORMATION

The attached memo contains more detailed information.

FISCAL and STAFF IMPACT

Minimal fiscal impacts accrue from receiving the report. The ultimate fiscal impact of the rescission on the Town cannot be determined until after an MPO decision.

Staff time will be necessary to participate in supplemental meetings of the Technical Coordinating Committee of the MPO to discuss how to respond regionally to the rescission.

RECOMMENDATION

Staff recommend that the Board of Aldermen adopt the resolution receiving the report.
