As I arrived on scene, the caller advised the subject just left the store. He was described as a black male wearing a brown jacket. I located the subject behind the store. The subject was identified as Barry Thornton. I asked Mr. Thornton if he had just used a credit card at CVS. Mr. Thornton advised that he had. I asked Mr. Thornton if I could see the card that was used. Mr. Thornton handed me a Bank of America debit card. The card belonged to Ryan Hanseler and had a picture of a white male on it.</p> <p>I asked Mr. Thornton where he got the card from. He advised a friend gave him the card and told him to go to the store. I asked Mr. Thornton to contact Mr. Hanseler so I could speak with him. Mr. Thornton was unable to contact Mr. Hanseler. Officer Beckert stood by with Mr. Thornton while I spoke with the caller, Ellen Griffith. Ms. Griffith stated that Mr Thornton entered the store and bought a carton of Newport cigarettes. She stated that Mr. Thornton swiped his card to make the purchase. She then advised that Mr. Thornton was asked to produce an ID along with the card because of the amount of the purchase. Ms. Griffith stated that Mr. Thornton put his thumb over the picture on the debit card when he showed her. He was unable to provide an ID. Ms. Griffith advised Mr. Thornton that he could not have the cigarettes. Mr. Thornton then left the store. At that time Ms. Griffith contacted the Carrboro Police Department. Ms. Griffith advised that Mr. Thornton returned a couple minutes later. He stated that he wanted a refund for the cigarettes since he was not allowed to have them. Ms. Griffith refused.
