	<p>arrival officers spoke with the complainant Angie Suitt. Ms. Suitt advised that Chandlers Towing was attempting to tow her vehicle even though she had obtained a permit from the office. Ms. Suitt had obtained a permit for the vehicle stating that if the vehicle was parked on the premises after 02/06/12 at 11:00 P.M it would be towed at the owners expense. The vehicle is a White 1984 Ford Crown Victoria N.C License Plate YRP-6220. The parking permit number given to Ms. Suitt is 1813. Ms. Suitt obtained the permit after the vehicle was tagged on 01/25/2012 by Chandlers Towing. The purpose of the tag put on the vehicle by Chandlers was for no parking permit and an out of date license plate. These were the two reasons that were checked on the green tag that was placed on the drivers window. I spoke with the driver of Chandlers Towing, Dale Austin and he advised that the permit Ms. Suitt received from the office was not for her license plate being out of date and that he was authorized to tow the vehicle. I explained to Mr. Austin that this would have to be cleared up with management at Royal Park because the parking permit authorizes the vehicle to be on the premises until 2/6/12. I asked Mr. Austin if he could contact an authorized person at Royal Park regarding the towing of the vehicle and he stated no. The problem is that a permit was given to Ms. Suitt authorizing the vehicle to be on the premises until 02/06/12 after it was tagged by Chandlers Towing. There is nothing on the permit stating that the vehicle still should be towed even though the permit is showing the vehicle is authorized until a certain date. Mr. Austin will contact his supervisors in order to clear the issue up with Management at Royal Park.
